







## Slope marking info sheet

Welcome to **Andermatt+Sedrun+Disentis**.




Your safety is our top priority. Please always follow the signs you encounter in our territory.

Especially, we would like to draw your attention to some differences in slope marking between North America and Switzerland.

### Switzerland


-  Gradient up to 25 percent
-  Gradient 25 to 40 percent
-  Gradient more than 40 percent
-  Ski route marked and secured, not groomed

### North America

-  Gradient 6 to 25 percent
-  Gradient 25 to 40 percent
-  Gradient more than 40 percent

## Secured and controlled slopes

All official and secured slopes are marked on both sides with poles (see picture 1 below). If you leave a marked slope, you are in the free ski area. This area is neither marked nor prepared, not controlled and not secured, since only open and marked runs are controlled by ski patrol and emergency service (see picture 2 below). Skiers and snowboarders who leave the marked slopes must be aware that they do so at their own risk. Be aware that you enter dangerous area with possibility of cliffs etc.
